Goods allowed

Penitentiary system

General

- Food can only be delivered in a period of 3 days before and after the inmates' birthday, at Easter (cutoff date: Easter Sunday) and at Christmas (cut-off date: 25.12.).
- The weight limit for food is max. 3 kg as well 4.5 liters for beverages (per inmate).
- Tobacco products, telephone cards (flashcodes), hygiene products/toiletries, newspapers, magazines can be delivered daily during the office hours. Money (cash) can be given (against receipt) daily from 8 a.m. to 4.45 p.m.
- All other goods can be delivered daily during the office hours until the weight limit of max. 30 kg.

Food

- Chocolate (without alcohol)
- Biscuits, sweets, chewing gum, cookies and bars
- Cereal, cornflakes
- Toast
- Fruits
- Milk UHT (0.5 L/per unit)
- Cake
- Mineral water/fruit drinks (PET bottles and tetrapak)
- Olives
- Nuts, cores (excluding walnuts)
- Chips
- Pralines, confectionary (without alcohol)
- Dates, figs
- Sugar/salt
- Honey/chocolate spread
- Tea bags (cardboard box)
- Syrup
- Chocolate powder/Ovomaltine etc., instant coffee
- Instant soups and instant noodles
- Tuna
- Mayonnaise/ketchup/mustard
- Dried meat (max. 150 g)
- Dietary supplement, for example: multi-protein, etc.

- Home-produced food is not permitted
- Only unopened original packaging (biscuits/cookies must be plasticised)
- Glass an tin packaging are not permitted
- Open and spoiled foods are not accepted
- Articles with alcohol are not permitted
- We only accept articles/food which are durable without refrigeration/cooling
- Only unopened original packaging as powder up to 1 kg-cans, made of plastic (Maximum quantity: 1 kg)

Tobacco products

- Cigarettes/rolling paper/filter
- Tobacco (bag/can)
- Lighter, matches
- Tamping machine for cigarettes (maximale size: 15 x 10 x 8 cm)
- Only unopened original packaging
- Tobacco products shall not be opened
- Glass an tin packaging are not permitted
- CBD-products, e-cigarettes, snus (moist tobacco for oral use), snuff tobacco and cigars are not allowed

Culture/religion

- Religious books
 - Prayer beads

Religious books and prayer beads that threaten security are not permitted

Vitamins/minerals

Various known products

- Only unopened original packagingVitamins must not be opened
 - Only conventional/known vitamins will be accepted

Other

- Board and dice games
- Coloured pencils/pens (standard)
- Thermosflask
- Pencil, eraser
- Envelope, stamps
- Writing paper
- Flashcodes

- Board and dice games made of metal or glass are not permitted
- Maximum Size of board and dice games: 40 x 40 cm.
